## POST-GAME NOTES AND QUOTES

Tampa Bay vs. Chicago  
November 20, 1983

WALTER PAYTON: This was Walter Payton's 53rd 100-yard rushing game. The NFL record is 58 by Jim Brown. It was his sixth against Tampa Bay, Chicago has won five of those games.

Payton now has 1,053 yards on the season. This is his seventh 1,000-yard rushing season, equaling an NFL record previously shared by Franco Harris and Jim Brown.

Payton moved into third place on the NFL's all-time career rushing list today, surpassing O.J. Simpson. Payton now has 11,257 yards rushing on his career, Simpson 11,236. Jim Brown's NFL record is 12,312, Franco Harris entered today's play with 11,725.

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY: "We played very poorly. Chicago outplayed us by quite a distance."

(Buc defense) "Two of our best defensive players didn't play. Based on today none of our players are going to the Hall of Fame, but then again neither am I."

(timeout called at the end of the first half): "I didn't want to. That's my privilege. When you get your team, you can call timeout."

(overall assessment): "Lousy. I think our backs ran pretty hard but they had no place to run. The fans should be happy they had Golsteyn."

(next week's quarterback): "If Thompson's well, Thompson is the quarterback. He's by far our best quarterback and has been all year."

(absence of Wilder): "I would have liked to have had Wilder and had them leave Payton at home."

"We thought we could run the ball and audibilize when they were in the fifty-one defense. We found out that we were not equal to being able to audibilize. It seemed we couldn't figure that out. We didn't audibilize, we didn't do anything. It's very frustrating. I'm going in and have a dry cigar."

CHICAGO COACH MIKE DITKA: "It's really evident we are a bad weather football team. We played our best. We put the responsibility on the linemen to block and they did a great job. In this kind of game, maybe a lot of people don't like to watch it but it makes us proud to be able to do what we did with our offensive and defensive lines."

"I gave the coaches the game ball and I feel very good about the way the guys have responded the last couple of weeks. So we have to keep it going, that's all."

(rain and the game plan): "We thought we could run on them. People hadn't been running on them but we thought we could. We put a couple of plays in, like the play Matt Suhey broke. He gained a lot of yards on that play alone."

"Look it, they (the Bucs) are hurting. They have a lot of people out of their lineup. You don't get the same type of play when you don't have Selmon out there. He is an exceptional football player. He keys that whole right side of their defense. I think with him in there it makes Green even better than he is which is good."

"It was great to have Dan Hampton back. We put him out there on the end and it seemed to give him a better way to go. I thought Jim McMahon did a good job, he really did. We didn't throw very much but when he did it was right there."
