JAMES WILDER now has 1,062 yards this season becoming the second Buc back in team history to earn that feat. Ricky Bell holds the club record with 1,263 yards in 1979. Wilder did not catch a pass in today's game ending an 18 game streak with at least two catches. The last game he was shut out in receptions was the second game of 1983 at Chicago. Wilder now has 1,502 total yards from scrimmage in 1984. Ricky Bell holds the single season Buc record in that category with 1,511 in 1979. So Wilder needs just nine yards to break that mark. Wilder is already the Bucs career leader in that category with 4,189 yards. Since moving to tailback last season, Wilder has now played 15 games and rushed for 1,533 yards in those games on 395 carries. With 72 catches for 568 yards in those games he has accounted for 2,101 total yards from scrimmage in 15 games at tailback.

MARK COTNEY's interception was his third in the last three games, with one in each. He now has 15 on his career.

CHRIS WASHINGTON's sack was his fourth this season as was DAVID LOGAN's. LEE ROY SELMON leads the team with five. SELMON had six quarterback pressures today.

OBED ARIRI is now 5-5 from inside 40 yards on field goals after going the first eight games of the season without an attempt of less than 40 yards.

STEVE DeBERG has now thrown for 200-plus yards in seven of the last eight games with his only non-200 yard game coming at Minnesota with 198. DeBerg was 16 of 28 for 238 yards giving him nine straight games with at least 15 completions. He also has six consecutive games with a TD pass.

KEVIN HOUSE has caught TD passes in five of the last six games. His four catches for 89 yards today all came in the second half.

QUOTES FROM GIANT COACH BILL PARCELLS:

"We just didn't play too well today. Tampa Bay played well on both sides of the ball. I really was not satisfied with anything today. (ON SIMMS THROWING LONG) We had trouble getting the ball downfield. We were able to hit the underneath stuff but not downfield. Defensively we struggled.
