Today was the 18th 100-yard rushing game of John Riggins' career. His 34 carries tied a team record set by Cliff Battles, 45 years ago in 1937, against the Eagles. It is the most individual rushing attempts against Tampa Bay surpassing three backs who carried the football 33 times against the Buccaneers (Earl Campbell, Walter Payton, and Billy Taylor, N.Y. Giants).

Tampa Bay injuries - Neal Colzie, hit in abdomen, in hospital for tests
Cecil Johnson, bruised cheekbone
Dana Nafziger, bruised shoulder
David Barrett, bruised hand

This was the fifth 100-yard receiving game for Kevin House. His 62-yard touchdown was the fourth longest pass reception of his career - the three longer plays were all last year.

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY: "We were beaten soundly. That's beginning to sound like a record."

(snap problem) - "It shouldn't have happened."

(touchdown called back) - "They said he stepped out of bounds before he caught the ball. It was probably a correct call. I don't think a guy could blow that."

(offensive line) - "They got awfully frustrated. We work out a deal. We're going to make a big play on the first play of the game and we fumble. We work it out again and we take the snap from center and we fumble. They are not really responsible for that but it's something you have to play through. But we just continued to give them the ball. Pretty soon you just lose the rhythm of the game."

"I thought in the second half for part of the game they did play fairly decently. I don't know how many times they got Doug but he shouldn't have grounded the ball. You just don't do that."

"We put our defense in a terrible position. At the end we knew we had to tackle high and try to knock the ball loose. We were eight points down, we needed more than a touchdown. A lot of our mistakes aren't made by the younger players. They are made by supposedly veteran players. So we'll just have to go back to work if they are here to work with."

(after snap fumbles) "We were really just in terrible position but our defense really stopped them several times. But you can't ask them to do it all day."

"We made enough errors to lose the game."

WASHINGTON COACH JOE GIBBS: "I personally feel very lucky that we were able to get a win because it was a mess out there today. A lot of things happened, the phones went out, sloshing around in the water. I knew it had to hurt Tampa Bay and it certainly hurt us also. I'm very thankful and I thank God for our players for having a chance to coach our players because they really fight. I think our guys fought very hard against a very good Tampa Bay team. We're just very fortunate to get a win."

"There was a lot of hitting going on. There were some real shots passed out. The mud made it a very physical game and I think everybody slows down a bit in weather like that. You get stood up and you get some shots."

(Riggins) "Riggins was just something else. I thought today he was something. He had a hip pointer and went back into the game and ran very hard."

"As a coach in a game like this everything gets fouled up because of the water problems. Without the phones you're guessing when you call plays. I don't think you get into a smooth rhythm with your offense and it becomes a game of breaks."

"I was very concerned that we didn't convert all the turnovers into scores. You get breaks like that and you want to convert them and we did not."

(Theismann in the rain) "I can think back and remember when I was coaching at USC and he threw (for Notre Dame) for what seemed like about 500 yards in such a rain. I think for some reason Joe can handle the ball well in the rain."
