POST GAME QUOTES TAMPA BAY VS MIAMI DOLPHINS

Coach Don Shula, "We missed a good opportunity to go 4-0, which would have put us top in the AFC. If you analyze it - we didn't play good enough to be 4-0. We got about what we deserved for our performance."

We don't show any rhythm in our offense, and we're having a tough time moving the ball consistently. I don't want to take anything away from the Tampa defense, I think they did a heck of a job."

Coach John McKay, "Well, we won. I got a call that Bear Bryant is the oldest coach in football, that I was the second coach in football. That's high school, college and professional. Tonight, I'm the oldest."

"We have more ways of making it look difficult. Miami played well, we played well - we won."

"They helped us. They dropped some balls that they normally would have caught. I think we hit them pretty good when we could get to them."

Asked about the playoffs. . .

"I think that any team that's 1-3 is still in it."

"I watched all the games turkey day, and I didn't see anything that amazed me. We unfortunately have to play New Orleans who is 3-1 and we have to play the Jets who are 3-1. We have our work cut out for us."

POST GAME QUOTES - 2

This was Doug Williams first non-100-yard passing game since October 26, 1980 at San Francisco when he passed for 80 yards. That breaks a string of 27 consecutive regular season games. Like tonight that game was a Tampa Bay victory:24-23.

This was the first time Tampa Bay has intercepted five passes in one game. The team record is six against New Orleans on December 11, 1977. Mike Washington and Neal Colzie became the 11th and 12th Buccaneers to intercept two passes in one game. It was the third time for Washington (he also did it in the six interception game with New Orleans) and the second time for Colzie (also opener vs. Minnesota last year, 9/5/81).

Colzie's 51-yard interception return was the fifth longest in Buc history. He has one of the four longer returns, 82 yards vs. Minnesota on 9/5/81

For James Owens, 82 yards is his second best day as a pro running back. His best is 112 vs. Green Bay in Tampa Bay's 1981 turnaround game on 11/22/81.

Of Miami's 330 yards in total offense, 196 came in the fourth quarter. 190 of that came by passing. Strock was 15 of 29 in the fourth quarter for 190 yards (three interceptions).

John McKay press conference - 10:30 a.m. as usual, tomorrow (Tuesday).

The Bucs outgained their opponents in the first three games and lost. The Bucs were outgained tonight and won.
