POST GAME NOTES & QUOTES

Tampa Bay vs. Pittsburgh
November 9, 1980

NOTES: Ricky Bell's fumble was his second of the season, first on a rushing play and first since the first game of the season at Cincinnati. That is 143 rushing attempts and 32 receptions... Doug Williams 302 yards passing is the third highest total of his career and his third 300-yard passing game. He passed for a career high 343 yards earlier this year against Cleveland ... the 26-yard touchdown reception by Kevin House was his first as a pro. The 26-yard score by the Buccaneers' second round draft pick in the last draft, followed an interception, the first of his pro career, by Scot Brantley, the Buccaneers' third round draft pick ... Jimmie Giles' 128 yards receiving is the highest total of his pro career (previous high - 105 yards at Dallas on 9/21/80) and the highest by a Buc receiver this year (Gordon Jones - 106 yards vs. Cleveland on 9/28/80) ... the crowd of 71,636 was the largest in house crowd to watch the Bucs during a regular season game at Tampa Stadium. The record is 72,033 for the NFC Championship Game with Los Angeles. Today's crowd exceeded the 71,402 who watched the playoff game with Philadelphia and the previous regular season high of 70,261 against the Giants on 11/18/79.

PITTSBURGH COACH CHUCK NOLL: (The final Tampa Bay pass) - "It looked to me like he just threw it away but you'll have to ask them on the other side."

(why did Stoudt play?) We just went to the bullpen and Cliff got the save."

"We are impressed with the personnel this football team has (the Bucs). They have a lot of talented players.

(302 yards for Williams? were you impressed?) Yes. (was it your defense?) Give credit to Doug Williams and his receivers.

We haven't experienced this type of heat and humidity. It was tough on our football team. It's cold up in our part of the country at this time of year.

Mistakes really hurt us, all kinds of mistakes, backs going the wrong way and not enough men on the field. If we eliminate the mistakes we'll be alright.

(How did Giles get so open on his touchdown?) We missed our coverage check. Our guy just forgot to cover the tight end. (Noll indicated that there was a change in the coverage called at the line).

(Jack Lambert) We didn't want to play Lambert but Dennis Winston hurt himself and we had to put Lambert in. (Winston's injuries) Heat and other things. (Didn't know what other things were). He (Winston) took himself out and we respect that decision.

I had hoped to put Stoudt in earlier.

OFFICIAL EXPLANATION OF FOURTH or FIRST DOWN PLAY AT END OF GAME (referee Fred Wyant):

(Jimmie Giles claimed that one official signalled first down) First of all I didn't see any official signal first down and in our discussion that we had none of the officials would have signalled first down, because it wasn't a first down.

(Giles says one official said first down as opposed to signalling) None of the officials would have said to him that it was a first down because the people that were on the line of scrimmage were right there. It wasn't a first down and the clocks had fourth down on it so there wasn't any question on that. I gave fourth down when I put the ball in play which I always do, fourth down and dropped it in. And there wasn't any question about it until they threw the incomplete pass and we turned it around to give the ball to the Steelers which it would have been at that particular time. But nobody said it was a first down, nobody signalled it was a first down because it wasn't.

(What is the procedure with the ball in that position for calling for a measurement?)

If in the opinion of the referee that it is close enough that he can't tell whether it was a first down, then I would stop the clock and call for a measurement. If it's a situation where in the referee's opinion, it's not close enough for a measurement we would not measure unless the captain, one of the captains requests for a measurement. If one of the captains asks for a measurement, then we will honor that request and call timeout and bring the stakes in, measure it even if everyone else thinks it's not. We honor that request. We received no such request, consequently put the ball down and put it in play and they threw the incomplete pass. We turned around to give the ball to Pittsburgh which ... you can't give a measurement at that time because they already got the stake right there and its short of the down marker.

NOTES AND QUOTES TWO

TAMPA BAY COACH JOHN MCKAY:

They told Giles and the other guys that it was a first down, the officials. The officials blew this one. If it wasn't a first down it was easy enough to measure the thing for a first down.

It was very close.

Giles said one of them told us it was. Whether it was or wasn't, all through the game they measured for it. Why didn't they measure for it then? I think they did a p--- poor job. We'll look at the pictures and be finally told that it was a first down.

Our people thought it was a first down. The people on the sidelines marking the ball thought it was a first down. The official didn't think it was a first down but in all games I have seen in this great league they usually come out like they did several times this afternoon and measure to see if it is a first down. There is no rule that says you can't measure in the last two minutes. We might not have won anyhow but give us an opportunity after all we were playing the Super Bowl champions.

(the last timeout?) He got in the wrong formation. He shouldn't have called a timeout and he called it. He should have run the play we sent in.

(explanation why they didn't call for a measurement) - They will give no explanation.

These people are a little bit higher than the Pope. When they come out there they are very powerful. They will go back to their business and make 12 dollars a week and come out .wk (Did anybody request a first down measurement?) Yes. Myself, the bench and everybody.

(blocked punt?) Some guy missed his assignment. (41? (Norris Thomas)) Yep. Who also missed practice last week.

You should be able to protect a punt if you are a grown adult. On the tipped pass before the half all you have to do is use two hands instead of one, it's not a one-handed game. Tennis, I think is a onehanded game.

I don't know anything about motivation. Motivation is for other expert coaches. I think we were motivated.

(Timeout after Giles catches the ball?) We couldn't afford to. We didn't want to use the last timeout. We had it going to where we wanted to, a field goal to get it into overtime. We can't expect to get the ball into the end zone, we wanted it where GARO has an opportunity. Doug just lined up and threw the ball, I had time to do nothing and he assumed it was first down. He said it was a first down, he argued with the official but you do not argue with an official in the National Football League.

I didn't see any signal of first down. We just assumed it was. It was either that much for a first down or that much it wasn't. But all afternoon they measured the thing for a first down. We think they should have stopped and measured for a first down. They didn't think they should, they belong to the commissioner, I don't, I'm wrong.

We thought we could pass on them, run on them. We didn't do as much as we thought we could have and that's why we're in the losing locker room.
