Notes and Quotes

The winner of next Sunday's Detroit-Tampa Bay game will be the NFC Central Division champion. Even if Green Bay defeats the New York Jets, the only way the Packers can win the division would be if Detroit and Tampa Bay tied.

Tampa Bay would have the advantage in a 9-7 tiebreaker with Green Bay by virtue of the Bucs two regular season victories over the Packers. A Detroit win would give the Lions the advantage in a 9-7 tie with Green Bay because of a 5-3 division record to 4-4 for Green Bay. The Lions and Packers split their regular season game.

BUC COACH JOHN MCKAY: "Well for a profound statement, we didn't play real well and got beat. The better team won, any questions?"

"(how do you get ready for Detroit?) - "Oh, I'd say play a little bit better."

"We played a very sporadic defensive game but the end result that they (the defense) got the ball back twice and we should have scored. With a field goal they wouldn't have touched us but we didn't do that."

(the interception) "As far as I'm concerned he had the ball in his (Giles) hands. But I don't see all 22 guys, I barely see myself out there. He tipped the ball."

(why was David Lewis in?) - "The fans wanted him. We do what the fans want."

SAN DIEGO COACH DON CORYELL: "The Bucs are tough. The NFC Central has been called weak and that statement is not true. And I think the view around the league is changing."

"I didn't think about the playoffs during the game. But we won the game and we're still in it. Had we lost it would have been over."

"Williams is very difficult to sack. He drops so deep and is so effective on the run."

"Hugh Green is great. I don't know how fast he is but he can fly."

"We took exactly what they gave us and used it to our best advantage. We have the type of offense that can adjust to any type of defense."

WES CHANDLER: "We stayed with our game. They took away the outside but they were taking deep drops so we went with our short passes. It was good to be back home."

GARY JOHNSON: "A player like Doug Williams has to be pressured. If we give him time he'll pick us apart."

San Diego is now 9-6. If the Chargers defeat Oakland a week from Monday night they would win the division in a head-to-head tie with Denver. Denver is 9-5 and playing Seattle in a late game.

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTES AND QUOTES

KELLEN WINSLOW: "I'm glad the Bucs are in the NFC. They're hitters, they're big and very talented. I feel they are so talented that it's only a matter of time before they dominate the NFC - a very short time."

DAN FOUTS: "I think Larry Weaver called a great game today. When you get the time to throw you get momentum. That's what we were able to do today. The Bucs mixed their coverages well but the main key was the time I had to throw. We have an offense designed to beat any coverage, because we take what teams give us. Sometimes they give us too much."

(the final field goal drive): "That was one of the most pressure-filled drives I've ever had."

(Doug Williams) "He's as good as any in the NFL I've seen and better than most who've been in the league (longer)."

RICHARD WOOD: "Playing in Detroit doesn't mean anything to us because we haven't played their this year."

"This is one of those games in pro ball where the game is won by inches."

LEE ROY SELMON: "This was a hard one to overcome because we came so close. It's important that we play well in the next ball game."

THEO BELL: "These guys are pros. We'll come back next week and put this game out of our minds. This game is history. I try to keep these guys fired up. I've been around. I've played with guys (the Steelers) that are no better than we are. They put their clothes on the same way you do."

(going to Detroit): "We have to go to a lot of places to play. We just have to go up in the right frame of mind."

DAVID LEWIS: "The coach told me, you've been here and you've got the experience. Coach took a gamble. I'm glad it paid off well for him."

"We wanted to win it in front of our fans because they've been great to us."

DOUG WILLIAMS: "If you're going to be a playoff contending team you can't be in a hurry. We looked at the clock and knew we had the time (he is referring to coming back from 21-10).

"We're in the situation now where we've got to win. Games like we've had the last two weeks are tough on a team. (on one field goal missing last week and this one good) Sooner or later the law of averages will catch up to you."

HUGH GREEN: "We had it today and we should have taken advantage of it. We'll just have to work harder."

CECIL JOHNSON: "We still have a chance. This game is not going to distract us. It hurts yes but we will show up at the Silverdome."

This was San Diego's sixth consecutive game gaining over 400 yards in total offense. That is a new NFL record for most consecutive 400-yard total offense games in one season. Houston had six straight once but it was over two seasons, presumably in the early 60's.

Should Tampa Bay lose to Detroit the Bucs would still be eligible to be an NFC Wild Card with an 8-8 record. Tampa Bay would win any tiebreaker with the New York Giants, St. Louis, Atlanta, Green Bay, Minnesota or Washington. Thus to make the playoffs in that eventuality (8-8), the following three things must happen:

1. Atlanta must lose one of its final two games (at Los Angeles, Monday night and vs. Cincinnati next Sunday).
2. Dallas must defeat the Giants in New York next Saturday.
3. The Jets must defeat Green Bay next Sunday in New York.

If the Giants defeat Dallas on Saturday, the loser of the Detroit-Tampa Bay game could not be the wild card.

The fumble lost by James Owens in the third quarter was the first fumble lost by a Buccaneer running back on a running play this year. Jerry Eckwood and James Wilder have both fumbled on pass receptions. It was Owens first fumble of the year.

Bill Capece's 49-yard field goal was his fifth field goal of 45 yards or longer in the last seven weeks. Tampa Bay placekickers had previously made only two 45-yarders or longer in the team's history.

Tampa Bay now has 30 interceptions on the season, a new team record. The previous best of 29 was in 1978. CEDRIC BROWN has his seventh of the year to break a four-way logjam at six for the old team record (Mike Washington and Neal Colzie this year and Brown in 1978).

Hugh Green caused James Brooks fumble, the fifth fumble he's caused this year.

This was Dan Fouts seventh 300-yard passing game of the season and the 25th of his career. He established an NFL record with eight 300-yard games last year. His 25 300-yard games now ties him with Sonny Jurgensen (17 seasons) for second on the all-time 300-yard game list behind Johnny Unitas. Unitas had 26 300-yard games in 18 seasons. Fouts is in his ninth NFL season.

This was Doug Williams ninth career 300-yard passing game, fourth of the season and second in a row.

With seven receptions today Charley Joiner of the Chargers now has moved into 13th place on the all-time career receiving list ahead of Don Hutson. He now has 489 career receptions.

Only one of Kellen Winslow's eight receptions was for over 10 yards.
